◆ 1. Square Reader

- **What it is:** Small Bluetooth card reader that links to a phone or tablet.
 - **Costs:**
 - Hardware: ~£20–£30 for the reader.
 - Transaction fee: 1.75% per payment, no monthly fee.
 - **Pros:** Easy to set up, good app with reporting, can also take contactless, Apple/Google Pay.
 - **Cons:** Requires smartphone or tablet with data connection.
-

◆ 2. Zettle by PayPal

- **What it is:** Card reader and mobile app.
 - **Costs:**
 - Reader: ~£29.
 - Transaction fee: 1.75%.
 - **Pros:** Backed by PayPal, fast settlement to bank account, supports invoicing too.
 - **Cons:** Also requires a phone/tablet with data.
-

◆ 3. SumUp Air

- **What it is:** Compact card reader working via phone or standalone 3G/4G terminal.
 - **Costs:**
 - Reader: £29 (Air) or ~£99 (3G with built-in SIM, no phone needed).
 - Transaction fee: 1.69%.
 - **Pros:** Simple flat pricing, 3G option works anywhere without Wi-Fi.
 - **Cons:** Limited reporting features compared to Square.
-

◆ 4. Dojo Go (by Paymentsense)

- **What it is:** More “professional” terminal used by pubs/events.
 - **Costs:**
 - Monthly rental from ~£15–£20.
 - Transaction fees: ~1.4% (negotiable).
 - **Pros:** Sturdy device, next-day settlement.
 - **Cons:** Higher fixed costs, better for regular/high volume use.
-

✔ **Best for occasional events:** *Square, Zettle, or SumUp Air* – minimal setup, no monthly fee, just transaction charges.

✔ **Best for regular use with higher volumes:** *Dojo Go* or a bank-provided terminal.
